

Painting the Middle Ground

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ACRYLIC CLASS MATERIALS LIST

This is a recommendation of materials for the acrylic class. You can certainly have more than these items and if the items listed are too much for you to purchase just get what you can. But please have professional quality paints, no craft or student level paints.

Paints (Liquitex, Graham, Holbein or Golden are the best)

Titanium White

Quinacridone Magenta (cool) or Cadmium Red (warm) or both

Hansa Yellow Light (cool) or Cadmium Yellow Med (warm) or both

Pthalo Blue (grn shade) or Ultramarine Blue or both

White Gesso (medium to large size)

Of course you can buy any additional colors you desire.

You might want to consider, light molding paste, matte medium gel, gloss varnish

Brushes

1 1/2" to 2" flat brush (Home Depot)

Both synthetic and bristle brushes

1/4", 1/2", 1" Brights (synthetics)

1/4", 1/2", 1" Bristles

Even larger sizes if you can.

Note: Make sure you get larger brushes rather than small brushes as we do loose paintings.

White Palette (white paper plates or a white metal Butcher Tray is best) No small palette with little bitty compartments please!

Roll of paper towels or Rags are best

Metal Palette Knife

Pencils, White Charcoal Pencil, Black charcoal stick

Tracing Pad (medium Size)

We will be painting in a minimum size of 18" x 24" up to as large as you want to go. We will be using stretched canvas, or watercolor paper.
