SUPPLIES:

- Drawing Board to fit 18" x 24" paper pads – REQUIRED FOR EVERY CLASS
- 18" x 24" OR 14" x 17" Strathmore 400 Series or 300 series drawing pad.
- Large Newsprint paper pad for warm-up exercises
- good quality tracing paper
- graphite pencils: 2H, H, HB, B, 2B, 4B
- exacto knife with replacement blades (for sharpening pencils)
- sandpaper block for sharpening pencils
- Kneadable eraser
- White plastic eraser
- (2) Large clips("bulldog" type)
- 12"-18" ruler (clear plastic ruler preferred)

I will announce when you will need the following supplies:

- 1 sheet of toned drawing paper, such as Canson (middle gray 18"x24")
- 1 sheet of Canson pastel paper, black
- Vine charcoal – will need a lot (a variety: soft and medium, thin and thick)
- Charcoal pencils, black (soft & medium) and white
- Conté sketching crayons, white, black, greys. These also can be purchased as sets.
- Blending stubs (tortillion)
- Odorless Spray Fixative (workable)

Drawing pad with drawing board, pencils, exacto knife with replacement blades, sandpaper block for sharpening pencils, soft vine charcoal, kneaded eraser, and a drawing board.
