

## Southern Watercolor Society 45th Annual Exhibit On Display at ArtCenter Manatee, April 12 – May 13, 2022

**BRADENTON, Fla.** March 16, 2022 – The beauty of watercolor. The diverse styles representing each artists' unique vision, along with the high technical quality of each piece, makes the 45th Annual Juried Exhibition of the Southern Watercolor Society (SWS) a must-see show. Selections will be made from a field of approximately 200 watercolor paintings representing artists from 19 southern states. The artists and their work present a compelling story of life, from portraits to street scenes and landscapes to abstracts. The masterful body of work is impressive.

Ken Call, the juror, has achieved signature status with AWS, NWS, MTWS, MOWS, IWS and has won numerous awards including 30 National and International Best in Shows, and his work has been featured *in Watercolor Artist, American Artist Watercolor* and most recently, the March issue of *The Art of Watercolour*. Ken will be teaching a workshop at ArtCenter Manatee April 12, 13, and 14, 2022. Each day will begin with a demonstration showing a different technique and approach to figure and portrait painting.
