Most if not all items can be purchased at Amazon, some can be found in Walmart or Hobby Lobby.

- General's Kimberly Graphite Drawing Pencils they come in a Set of 3 or 10.
- General White Charcoal pencil
- Canvas Board 11x14 inches
- For beginners, U.S. Art Supply Professional 36 Color Set of Acrylic Paint (\$15) on Amazon
- For Intermediate to Advance, Liquitex brand heavy body, BLICK Studio Acrylic.
- Plastic Palette Knives. They come in different shapes and sizes, diamond, thin diamond, flat, scraper and trowel.
- Don't spend too much on brushes. You can purchase a set of "Simply Simmons" OR W.A. Portman brushes on Amazon for a reasonable price (\$19). Included in the set, a flat in different sizes, filbert, and round in different sizes.
- Disposable Palette Pad for Acrylic.
- Paper Towels
- 18" clear plastic ruler
- Moo eraser from Amazon
- Plastic spray bottle, from Walmart
- Large plastic container for water
