Paints: Please have professional paints, either Liquitex or Golden Heavy Body or Fluid. You will not be happy if you use the student (Basics) products.
Colors: Use what you have and here are suggestions.
Titanium White
Quinacridone Magenta
and/or Cadmium Red Light
Benzimidazolone Yellow Light and/or Cadmium Yellow Medium
Pthalo Blue (grn shade)
and/or Ultramarine Blue
White Gesso
Black Gesso
Of course you can buy any additional colors you desire.
Brushes, Use what you have and here are suggestions.
2" flat brush (Home Depot)
Bristle Brushes (Hog Hair or similar)
$1 / 4$ ", $1 / 2$ ", 1 " Brights
Acrylic Synthetic Brushes - buy the best you can afford or..
$1 / 4$ ", $1 / 2$ ", 1 " Brights
You can buy some rounds also if you want to
No. 3 Soft Synthetic Round

White Palette (white paper plates or a white metal Butcher Tray)
Large plastic water containers
Rags rather than paper towels
Metal Palette Knife (Liquitex Free-style or similar)
Pencils, White Charcoal Pencil, Black charcoal stick
You can paint on anything you like. Larger the better. Square canvases are great, 20x20, $24 \times 24$
