

ACRYLIC CLASS SUPPLY LIST

The following checklist is designed to help you with the purchase of some or all the art supplies you might need. If you have supplies from a previous class, please bring them, and then we can decide if you need to purchase other items. Most, if not all, items can be purchased at Amazon, Cheap Joe's, or other art supply stores like Blick.

- Stretched Canvas or Canvas Board 11x14
- ***NOTE: make sure that the canvas is Acrylic Primed.
- Acrylic Paint Liquitex **heavy body** brand to start with; they come in an intro set of 6 for approximately \$25.00. You might need an Extra tube of Titanium White.
- Plastic metal Palette Knives. They come in different shapes and sizes: diamond, thin diamond, flat, scraper, and trowel.
- Do not spend too much on brushes. You can purchase a "W.A. PORTMAN LTD" set on Amazon for a reasonable price. The set includes a flat in different sizes, filbert and round in different sizes, and the CASE.
- Disposable Palette paper, 9x12, is preferable.
- Other items, pencils including white charcoal pencil, graphite # H & 6B, an art gum eraser, an 18" clear plastic ruler and a plastic container for water, a small plastic mister (spray travel bottle), and paper towels. If you have any acrylic supplies from a previous class, please bring them. If you have watercolor brushes, they can also be used for Acrylics.

We will work from photographs; the best ones are normally yours. You can also find thousands of pictures that are not copyrighted by professional photographers. The two websites I command are:
